ABOUT WHITE CARD TRAINING

Work Health and Safety (WHS) induction training is a requirement for persons wanting to work in the construction industry or go onto a construction site. Our White Card Construction Induction course covers the basic WHS knowledge required to gain entry to any construction site within Australia.

Students will gain the knowledge and ability to demonstrate an understanding of WHS legislative requirements, basic principles of risk management, prevention of injury and illness in the construction industry.
